everything subordinates itself to the annual cycle:



- for free







Extended Site Configuration




- settings.yaml per site to replace constants in the long run

Routing Initiative

TYPO3 should support "speaking urls" /
"routes" out of the box without the
necessity of using a third-party
extension like RealURL or CoolURI.
Additionally there should be an API to
generate links to routes independent of
the current context (for example
frontend vs. backend link generation).


Routing Initiative

Localization with Crowdin Initiative




PWA Initiative

Progressive Web Apps are a hot topic currently. It allows mobile websites to look and feel like native apps, work offline or be installable and more.


TYPO3 should make it easy to build progressive web applications.


