Dear Professor Thirring,

It gives me much pleasure in extending to you an invitation to become a member of the CONSULTATIVE COUNCIL TO THE WORLD CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION which will begin its task of drafting a Constitution for a World Federation on August 27, 1968, in Interlaken (Switzerland). This COUNCIL to which you are invited assembles for five days in Interlaken, from August 27 (at 10 a.m.) to August 31, while the ASSEMBLY OF DELEGATES has been convoked from August 27 (at 8 p.m.) to September 1 in Interlaken and thereafter from September 2 (10 a.m.) in Wolfach (Germany). The enclosed memorandum of the undersigned, dated May 6, 1968, will give you the background story of the CONVENTION.

The COUNCIL's task, in which you are invited to participate will be mainly of a scientific nature; to engage in research and give advice on specific topics connected with the drafting and ratification of a World Constitution. The task of the ASSEMBLY OF DELEGATES, which will meet separately, will be mainly of a political nature; to elaborate the text of a World Constitution which would have a chance of being ratified by the necessary majority of the nations of the world.

The scientific and the political work will thus be done in separate bodies and I appeal to you to help us in the capacity of CONSULTANT.

If you can accept this invitation please indicate whether you can co-operate in the English language or whether translations would be necessary in discussion and documentation. Please let us also know whether you will assume all the expense of your co-operation or whether you would need assistance. Up to now we have no funds for this purpose. If you cannot come to Interlaken but would wish to co-operate in the future, please inform us.

A form for booking rooms in Interlaken is also enclosed.
