NOTES ON THE NATIONAL POLICY OF THE UNITED STATES AS TO THE USE OF CHEMICAL AND BIOLOGICAL WARFARE

1. Upon entering World War I, the U. S. found that the opposing sides were already committed to the use of toxic chemicals. In the propaganda campaign we had indicated our dislike for such weapons; however, at the time of the armistice, Prentiss in his book "Chemicals in War" estimated that 50% German, 35% French, 25% British, and 15% of American shell were chemically filled, but with the close of the war, the American shell program had expanded to 25% of the artillery shell.

2. At the Washington Conference in 1921 a statement was made against chemical warfare; however, this treaty was not ratified by France and therefore did not bind the U. S. which had ratified the treaty. The year following, 1922, the Chemical Warfare Service was directed to restrict itself to defensive aspects of CW with the exception of research and development.



COUNTER-ESPIONAGE SUMMARY #3

I. OVERALL SITUATION

Intelligence from sources in virtually all areas of the world is accumulating to verify our previous report that the Japanese regard their surrender as a temporary capitulation; that the defeat is of the Military and not of the Government. Their plan to resuscitate their empire is readily deduced from orders known to have been transmitted to their intelligence organizations throughout the world. These have directed that secret intelligence operations should continue at present locations as quietly as possible. One report from a fairly reliable source is to the effect that they plan to await an expected economic crisis in the United States and then conduct subversive
