Power Production

Please excuse the delayed answer to your letter of August 8th. I have tried in the meanwhile to obtain material about the latest development in the field of power production in Great Britain and Russia. According to an official report published July 1956 by the Reference Division, Central Office of Information London W 1, entitled The British Commonwealth and Nuclear Engineering, the table on Page 350 of my book is still quite correct. Just a slight correction could be made at the foot of p. 346 by changing the future tense into the imperfect regarding Calder Hall. I am enclosing a slip for the printer.

Concerning the Russian projects: I could not find any information that the sixth Five Years Plan (1956-1960) on which my data are based was changed or cancelled. So all IXEME to be correct on p. 348 ff.
